MATCHA GRADE CHART

CEREMONIAL MATCHA



Used for traditional Matcha ceremonies where tea is drunk alone. The ceremony aims to appreciate complex flavour notes.



Harvests of Spring tea leaves



Brighter & more vibrant green powder



Sweeter notes accompanying bitter undertones

CULINARY MATCHA



Used predominantly for culinary purposes. Its bitterness brings out the distinct flavour when mixed with other ingredients.



Harvests of Summer & Autumn tea leaves



Paler & less vibrant green powder



Bitter notes accompanying bitter undertones

Bitter Tones
Bright

Vibrant

Late Summer
Unpalatable
Light Olive
